

GROUNDBREAKING RESEARCH: UNVEILING KNEE OSTEOARTHRITIS PREVALENCE IN THE UAE

e are thrilled to announce that Shabina Qureshi (MPT 2021, Gulf Medical University) has achieved a significant academic milestone, with her research being published in the esteemed Middle East Journal of Rehabilitation and Health Studies. Her impactful scoping review, titled 'Prevalence of Knee Osteoarthritis in the UAE: A Scoping Review, sheds crucial light on a prevalent health concern within the UAE. This publication not only underscores GMU's commitment to academic excellence but also highlights the tangible real-world impact of its graduates contributions to healthcare knowledge.

Understanding the Scope of Knee Osteoarthritis in the UAE

Osteoarthritis (OA), particularly affecting the knee, presents a substantial global healthcare burden. Recognizing this, Shabina's research embarked on synthesizing existing literature

to accurately determine the prevalence of knee OA in the UAE. The study meticulously searched electronic databases like Ebscohost-Medline, Embase, Scopus, and others, meticulously sifting through over 25,000 potential records.

A critical finding from Ms. Qureshi's review is the strong association between age and Body Mass Index (BMI) as key risk factors contributing to the rising incidence of knee OA in the UAE. This aligns with global understanding, where related changes in joint tissues and the mechanical stress from increased BMI are recognized drivers of the condition. The study also highlighted concerns regarding the methodological rigor of the identified research, suggesting variations due to geographical location, sample recruitment, and case definitions. These inconsistencies underscore the need for more robust and standardized methodologies in future research to ensure accurate comparable and prevalence estimates.

Implications for Healthcare and Future Research

This comprehensive scoping review, conducted under stringent guidelines, represents a vital step towards understanding knee OA in the UAE. By identifying the current landscape highlighting gaps in existing research, her publication serves a foundational resource healthcare professionals, for policymakers, and researchers. It strongly advocates for future studies to employ more rigorous methodologies to provide precise

prevalence assessments, ultimately enabling the development of more effective strategies to alleviate the burden of knee OA in the UAE. We congratulate Ms. Shabina Qureshi on this outstanding achievement, which truly reflects GMU's dedication to fostering research that makes a difference.
